- Help students make **links** to other subjects
- Help students **learn how to learn**

Address the following Key questions

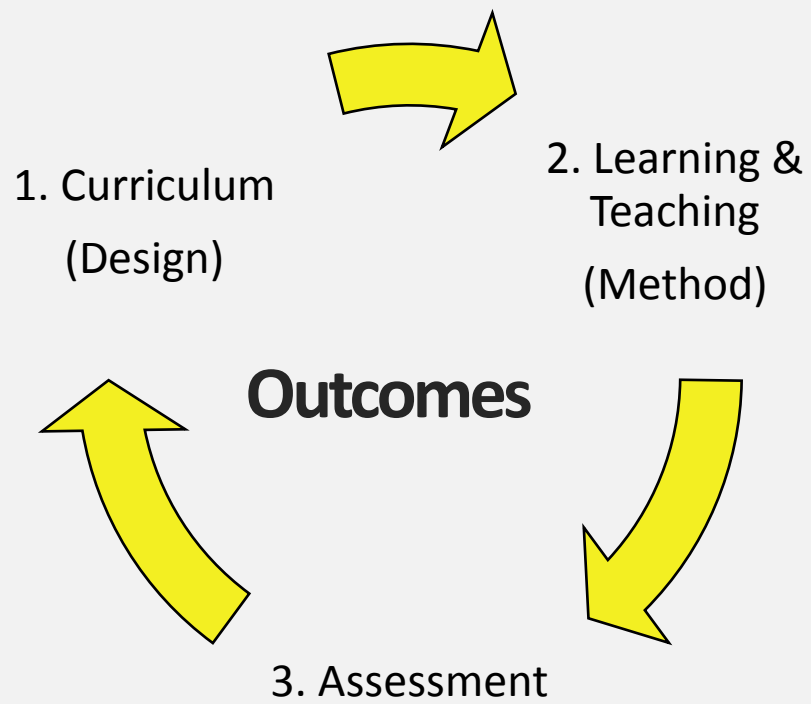
- What do you want the student to have or to be able to do?
- How can you best help student achieve it?
- How will you know whether they have achieved it?
- How do you measure the attainment?

What is Outcome Base Education ?

Outcome – based education means starting with a clear picture of what is important for **students to be able to do**, then **organising the curriculum, instruction** and **assessment** to make sure that this learning ultimately happens.

Teaching and Learning Methods aligned with LO

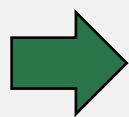
3. How you will judge how well your students have learnt ?
